Background:

On VMWare based Virtual Machines running on Windows 10 platforms only, Installing PADSVX.2.6 might hang. In order to work around this problem, follow the steps below by setting a System Variable _JAVA_OPTIONS=-Dsun.java2d.d3d=false

Steps:

 Go to System Properties -> Environment Variables -> New and add the following variable: Variable name: __JAVA_OPTIONS Variable value: -Dsun.java2d.d3d=false

Please pay attention to these details:

Variable name has an "underscore" in the beginning _JAVA_OPTIONS and the variable value begins with a "dash" and has an all lower case "false" in the end -Dsun.java2d.d3d=false
